Etiquette

Respect and integrity is fundamental to the game of Golf.

Respect the course. Please leave the course as you would like to find it by repairing pitch marks, replacing divots and raking bunkers. Please do not practice on the course.

Respect fellow players. Be sporting and polite, stay by the green to watch players hole out but avoid distracting them. Remain constantly aware of other players and wait for players in front to move forward before playing your ball. If a wayward ball is heading in the direction of other players always give a warning by shouting 'Fore!'

Try not to hold up players behind through slow play.

If you are delaying the group behind by a clear hole, invite them to play through.

Using abusive, degrading, discriminatory or foul language is unacceptable on the course or in the clubhouse.

Respect the game by following the rules of golf.

Members and Visitors Dress Code

The club wishes to preserve a respectable 'smart casual' approach to dress code.

We would appreciate your support in maintaining the following:

- **Trousers:** tracksuit/joggers are not considered appropriate on the course or in the clubhouse.
- **Shirts:** Football shirts should not be worn on the course or in the clubhouse.
- **Shorts:** should be tailored of respectable length.
- **Caps/hats:** should be worn outside only.
- **Shoes:** shoes worn for golf should be changed before going into the clubhouse.
- **Golf bags and equipment:** we request that these are not brought into the clubhouse.
